What is Blooddrag? Well The Blooddrag Show is a "blood drive" car show, but if you own a custom vehicle you don't "drive" them. Drag racers "Drag" them, lowriders and mini truckers "Drag" frame and body, even the sound competitions are called DB "Drags" so the Blood Drive show became the Blooddrag Show. It was started in 1999 for President of a local club I was in, who was hit by a drunk driver on his motorcycle.

The last year Blooddrag was in West Palm Beach, FL was in 2003. We had 800 registered vehicles and 5,500 people thru the gates and raised 181 pints of blood in 3 days. Now after a 10 year tour around the country in places like Live Oak FL, Anderson SC, Atlanta GA, Bowling Green KY and even Riverside CA it's time for it to come home to West Palm Beach FL. Just the rumor of the show's return has already caused a lot of buzz around FL and adjoining states. The next Blooddrag, is happening February 9th 2013 will be benefiting the Shriners of Palm Beach County and will be held at their beautiful fairgrounds in Palm Beach Gardens. We've also added an indoor building that will hold the Blood Sweat & Gearz Tattoo & Art Expo during the Blooddrag show. Blooddrag is open to all Hot Rods, Customs, Classics cars, Muscle cars and trucks of all kinds. Show classes will be Top 30 plus 15 best of's. The show will be hosted by No Regrets and Florida based hot rod club The Salvagerz. Judging will be a ballot system; each registered vehicle gets a ballot where they vote for 3 other registered vehicles (not in their club) this way the field is judged by its peers.

Blooddrag has been featured in many national and international publications like Truckin' Street Trucks, Sport Truck, Street Scene, Low-Rider, Low-Rider Euro, Tailgate, High Beans, Mini Truck'in, 8-Lug, Truck Trends (Japan) and Performance & Auto Sound (Canada)

Blooddrag will also feature special guests like Lou Santiago, from Muscle Car TV on Spike, and Car Fixx on Velocity as master of ceremonies. We will also have Rick Bacon, from Muscle Car TV on Spike, as guest judge for the best of's and Shane Turgeon, world famous tattoo artist, for the tattoo judging.

As always Blooddrag's first rule is, anyone that donates blood will get into the show for free. Kids under 12 are **FREE** Spectators are **FREE** With blood donation or \$10 admission. All Military, Fire Fighters & Police / Sheriff with proper ID are **FREE**.

Your application, required forms below and booth fee must be submitted in order to secure your spot. Refunds will not be given unless the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. There will be a total of 30 vendors inside the main building. 10 booths are reserved for Tattoo artists and the rest will be for artists or vendors selling art and handmade goods. Booths will be given on a first come first serve basis. Artists, crafters and tattoo booths will all be located indoors in the main building. Tablecloths and booth dividers will not be provided. Nothing can be nailed, taped or mounted to the walls. All booths are available on a first come first serve basis.

TATTOO ARTIST BOOTH=

\$125 and are approximately 10' x10' with electric. Tattoo booths come with (3) vendor wristbands, (2) parking passes, (2) 8' tables, (4) chairs, a garbage can, bio waste box and sharps container. There will be a courtesy artist's station set up with Thermo Fax, and copier.

REQUIRED=

Effective January 1, 2012, the Florida Department of Health now requires all tattoo artists to be licensed in the state of Florida. You must return all the paperwork below to tattoo at this show. There will be no exceptions as the Health Department WILL be checking for proper paperwork to be on file.

Please send with this application a copy of:

- Your current shops Business Licenses
- Valid State of Florida Tattoo Artist License (More information can be found here <http://www.doh.state.fl.us/Environment/community/Tattoo/index.html>)
- Passing spore test from the autoclave used to sterilize any reusable equipment you will be bringing.
- Your client 'Consent to Tattoo' form that you will be using the day of the show.

By signing below you understand that:

You must maintain proper records complete with drivers licenses number and age for each person tattooed the day of the show. No persons under the age of 18 will be tattooed. No piercing is to be done at all at this show. Booths must be kept clean and in sanitary condition at all times. Bio waste cans are not to be used for regular trash. Bathroom sinks are NOT to be used for anything other than washing hands. Separate sinks are provided for tattoo related washing needs.

ARTISTS / CRAFTER BOOTH=

\$75.00 Approximately 8' x8' and comes with (1) 8' tables, (2) chairs and (3) vendor wristbands, (1) parking pass. Booths are located inside the main building.

(please note ALL event wristbands will include entrance to the Spearmint Rhino after party)

OUTSIDE VENDORS (automotive) BOOTH=

\$100.00 for each 10 X 10 (unlimited on space purchased) comes with, 1 sponsor vehicle space, (2) vendor wristbands, (1) parking pass. Booths are located in vendor row, outside the main building.

(please note ALL event wristbands will include entrance to the Spearmint Rhino after party)

LOAD IN & DAY OF SHOW::

Gates outside will open to the public at 9am. The Art and Tattoo expo building will be open to the public from 10:00 am until 5:00 pm. Morning of please check in at the front door of the building to receive your vendor badges. Any additional passes may be purchased for \$5.00 day of until the gates open at 9am. Vendor, Artists unloading and registered vehicles in the show may set up the day before the show on Friday from 3pm to 6pm or Saturday 7am to 9am. ****NO vehicles permitted on site after 9am day of show.**** Once you are unloaded we ask that you move your car to the designated parking lot. Security will be provided the day before the show but It is up to you to watch your booth at all times during the show. Vendor building doors will open at 10am. Cebreco, Inc. will not be responsible for theft, breakage, and/or any loss of merchandise. Doors close at 5:00pm and breakdown should not begin any sooner. We would like everyone to be out the door by 7pm.
